SUBJECT: Nomination and Election of Chair and Vice Chair of the Commission for the term of April 2022 to April 2023, and possible direction to staff.

SUMMARY

Section 39 of the WRWC Act, Chapter 531, Statutes of Nevada 2007 (the “Act”), requires that the Northern Nevada Water Planning Commission (“NNWPC”) “establish a schedule for the selection of its Chair for a term of one year, in rotation, from among the members.” The Act identifies the voting members of the NNWPC by title, position, or interest to be represented. The Act is silent concerning a Vice Chair and does not prohibit selection of one. Prior to adoption of the NNWPC Administrative Policies and Procedures on May 5, 2010, a Vice Chair was selected by custom and practice to preside over meetings in the absence of the Chair. Section V of the NNWPC Administrative Policies and Procedures provides for the selection of a Chairman and a Vice Chairman, for a term of one year, in rotation, from among the voting members, annually, at the first meeting in April.

All twelve NNWPC voting member positions have been selected and have served as Chair one time in rotation. Two member positions which have served twice, and are currently ineligible for selection, are the Washoe County Water Conservation District and the City of Sparks representatives.
